## Approved Basic Life Support Certification Courses Updated November 2025

Proposed changes, if passed during the 2026 Legislative Session will become effective for the 2026 CE Reporting Period, include a requirement that **ALL** Licensed Optometrists in West Virginia must maintain Certification in Basic Life Support from the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association or other Board approved certified organizations.

Optometry licensees should select a Healthcare Provider BLS course that includes both CPR (with hands on portion) and AED training.
